Exercise A

The game of tennis began in France in around 1100. Then, the players batted a ball back and forth across a net with the palms of their hands. Modern tennis began much later. In 1873, Major Walter Clopton Wingfield made some variations on the old game. His new game was soon called *lawn tennis*. In 1877, the All England Croquet and Lawn Tennis Club held the first tennis tournament ever. The tennis tournament took place in Wimbledon, outside of London. Since those early days, tennis has become popular around the world.

Ice climbing was first recognized as a sport in the 1960s. Athletes hike into mountains and sometimes find frozen waterfalls hundreds of feet high. Participants in this sport need special equipment, such as two axes with serrated teeth. Climbers have metal cleats on their boots. They push the cleats into the ice for a good grip. They also carry ropes with them on their climbs. They use the ropes for tying themselves to screws in the ice. Ice climbing is a dangerous sport. Climbers should try this sport only with other climbers.
